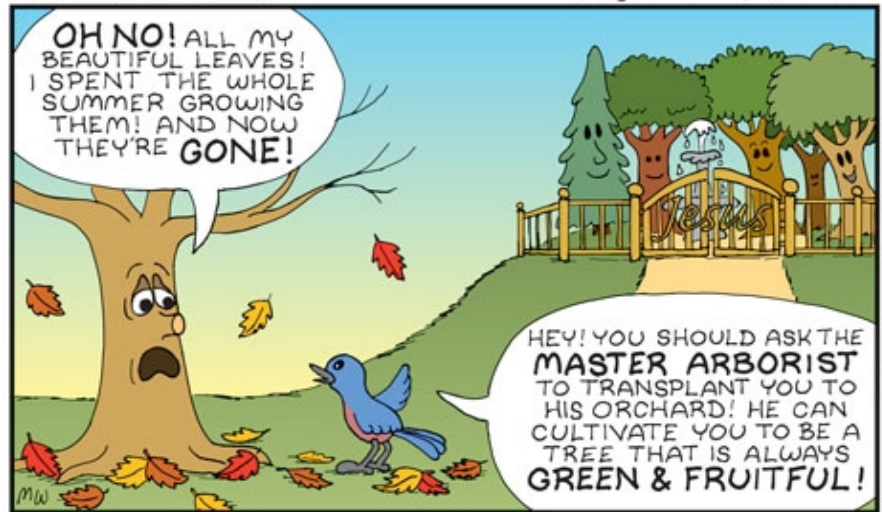

Did You Know:

“It is Well” was written by Horatio Spadford and Philip Bliss. The hymn was written after several traumatic events in Spadford's life. The first was the death of his first son in 1781 followed by the Chicago Fire. Then in 1873, he planned to travel to Europe with his family on the S.S. Ville du Harve, but sent the family ahead. After a collision with another ship, the Ville du Harve sank, killing all four of his daughters, but his wife Anna survived. Shortly after meeting up with Anna, he wrote the song as he passed near where his daughters died.
